Within each World Bank category, Members and sub-national Members may apply for a fee reduction if their IAMRA membership fee exceeds US\$0.50 per licensee. Documentation, such as an annual report that verifies the medical regulatory authority's licensee number, is required in support of the application. If approved, the fee will be reduced to that of the next lower World Bank category.
